



“So, do we have a contract yet?”

Many people have been asking, so here is the latest information. Pastor Rob met with Ed Bachrach and Ron James Monday, and then Pastor Wray and Pastor Rob met with our lawyer, Scott Murphy, Wednesday to finalize details of the contract. We have agreed on the details of the contract and are now just trying to get the final wording. With much hard work we believe we are now within a few days of having a contract to sign.

We have received positive feedback from Phil Cochran who is working with us on the rezoning petition. We submitted this on September 1 and will follow it through to the City Council decision on October 15. Please pray that the Zoning and Planning Commission will receive our petition well.

The building committee will have its first forum this Sunday to talk about the sanctuary and many of the building topics related to worship. They are also looking through information from a number of architectural/engineering firms to determine who we will work with on this project.

We still anticipate being able to finalize the contract and complete our due diligence so that we can close by the end of this calendar year. This was the time frame we originally hoped for, and we are hopeful that we can meet it.

Continue to pray for God’s clear direction in this process. Pray for our leaders and for all in our congregation working so hard on this. Pray especially that zeal for Jesus and His mission will grow stronger in every member of our congregation every day.
